### Submission

This Journal recommends that authors follow the Uniform Requirements for Manuscripts Submitted to Biomedical Journals formulated by the International Committee of Medical Journal Editors (ICMJE).

Only manuscripts of sufficient quality that meet the aims and scope of Clinical and Translational Neuroscience will be reviewed.

#### Conditions

As part of the submission process you will be required to warrant that you are submitting your original work, that you have the rights in the work, that you are submitting the work for first publication in the Journal and that it is not being considered for publication elsewhere and has not already been published elsewhere, and that you have obtained and can supply all necessary permissions for the reproduction of any copyright works not owned by you.

#### How We Edit

Submissions are subject to a rigorous, single-blinded peer-review by at least two of our journal's more than thirty members of the editorial board. During this process, authors will be able to check the progress of their contributions through the journal's website.

#### **Open Access**

Clinical and Translational Neuroscience is an open access journal. Each article accepted by peer review is made freely available online immediately upon publication, is published under a Creative Commons license and will be hosted online in perpetuity. Publication costs of the journal are covered by the collection of article processing charges which are paid by the funder, institution or author of each manuscript upon acceptance.
